**Notice of Race**

**1. Venue and Date**

The Championship will be held from Wednesday, August 23 to Sunday, August 27 2006 in Brunnen on Lake Lucerne.

**3. Rules**

3.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing ISAF, including the additional prescriptions of Swiss Sailing.

3.2 The "Regulations for Swiss Championships" of Swiss Sailing will apply.

3.3 Swiss federal law for inland navigation with local amendments will apply.

3.4 If there is a conflict between languages the German text of the Notice Of Race will prevail.

**4. Eligibility**

4.1 The regatta is open to boats from other countries.

4.2 Competitors must be members of a Club affiliated to ISAF. For Swiss competitors the amendments of Swiss Sailing to the Eligibility Code will apply.

**5. Advertising**

5.1 Advertising Category C will apply.

5.2 If requested advertising of the main sponsor of the event is provided on the boats.

**6. Entry**

6.1 Entries shall be submitted on the enclosed Entry Form, completely filled out.

Copies of the following documents shall be enclosed:

- Measurement Certificate

- Confirmation of the legitimacy for advertising Category C
  - Confirmation of the third-party liability insurance.

- 6.3 Deadline for Entries:  
 Entries shall be received by the Organizing Authority no later than July 31<sup>st</sup> 2006 (post stamp). Late entries will be accepted until August 15th 2006.
- 6.4 Entry fee: CHF 120.- (EURO 80.-) per boat.  
 Entry fee for late entries: CHF 150.- (EURO 100.-) per boat.  
 Foreign competitors can pay the entry fee at the check-in.

## **7. Schedule of Races**

- 7.2 Scheduled Races:
- The Championship will be sailed with 9 valid races.
  - To constitute the Championship at least 4 valid races must be sailed during the scheduled time.
  - At one day no more than 4 valid races will be sailed.

## **8. Measurement**

- 8.1 The check of the Measurement Certificates and the control measurements will take place near the Clubhouse.
- 8.2 No first measurements will be carried out.

## **9. Scoring**

- 9.2 The Low Point Scoring System of Appendix A will apply.
- 9.2 Excluding worst scores:  
 1 worst score will be excluded after 5 valid races.  
 2 worst scores will be excluded after 9 valid races.

## **10. Prizes**

- 10.1 The following prizes will be awarded:
- Championship medals for the first 3 boats
  - Prizes for the first 6 boats
  - Souvenirs for each competitor
- 10.1 Prizes and souvenirs will be awarded as well, if only 1 valid race can be sailed.

## **11. Mooring and Parking**

- 11.1 For every boat a suitable place will be provided. Arrangements of the harbour administrator must be respected.
- 11.2 A special parking lot will be marked for the trailers.
- 11.3 A special parking lot will be marked for cars. Parking on public parking lots of the harbour is prohibited for competitors.

## **12. Support boats**

- 12.1 Support boats shall be registered at the race committee before the beginning of the event.  
12.2 Support boats will be part of the security arrangement for the event.

### **13. Social Events**

The following events will be organized:

- August 25: Dock party after return to the harbour  
Yearly meeting of Swiss Finn Association
- August 26: Dock party after return to the harbour  
Sailors dinner at the club house

- 14.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk (See RRS rule 4 - Decision to race). The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
- 14.2 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with adequate cover per event and valid for racing.
