## **NOTICE OF RACE**

The Federation Francaise de Voile and the Yacht Club of Cannes are pleased to invite you to participate in the *CANNES INTERNATIONAL SAILING WEEK* from the february 17th to the 20nd 2009.

### **1. Organizing Authorities**

The French Sailing Federation  
The Yacht Club of Cannes.

### **2. Rules**

The regatta will be governed by the current ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing, the prescriptions of the French Sailing Federation and the current class rules.

### **3. ISAF Classification**

The regatta is an ISAF GRADE 2 ranked event for Olympic classes.

### **4. Eligibility and Entries**

The event is open to any boat from the international Finn class, according to the current Finn class rules.

French competitors will provide a valid 2009 FFV licence, bearing a medical endorsement.

Entries must reach the Yacht Club of Cannes

Competitors must present the following document when signing on:

An authorisation to carry publicity, if applicable.

Foreign competitors must present a third party insurance certificate or subscribe for a French Sailing Federation insurance called "licence".

Competitors must have a valid IFA sticker.

### **Entry Fee: € 75**

payable to the Yacht Club de Cannes.

### **Entry fee for boats registered after February 12th 2009 are increased:€ 90**

The number of entries will be restricted to 100 boats

### **5. Advertising**

C event category.

### **6 Program**

16th February: registration

17th February: registration, first start at 14.00.

18th February: first start at 11.00

19th February: first start at 11.00

20th February: first start at 10.00, prize giving

### **8. Racing Area**

"Upwind-downwind" races in Cannes' East or West Bays.

### **9. Penalties**

In accordance with the current Racing Rules of Sailing and the 2009 class rules.



### **10. Scoring**

Low points system will apply.

The maximum number of races to be sailed is 9. 4 races are required for the regatta to be validated, if 5 or more races are sailed, the worst result will be discarded from the final score. The rule A 1.3 of the RRS will apply.

### **11. Responsibilities**

Any competitor who is taking part in the regatta do so entirely at their own risk – see rule 4 of the Racing Rules of Sailing. The decision to race – the organizing authorities do not accept any responsibility in the case of damage to equipment, injuries or death within the framework of the regatta, which includes before, during the after the regatta.

### **12. Measurement**

Any competing boats must conform to the class rules.

### **13. Insurance**

Each participating boat must own a valid third part insurance or equivalent, for the event.

### **14. Boat Parking**

Boats will be parked at the Yacht Club de Cannes.
