

THE QUALIFICATION SYSTEM FOR THE 2007 ISAF WORLD SAILING CHAMPIONSHIPS



1. General conditions

- 1.1 Entry places at the 2007 ISAF World Sailing Championships (the Championships) will be allocated to MNAs in 3 ways:
- (a) Priority places - All MNAs are entitled to 1 entry place in each class, provided that the MNA applies for its entry place before 1 January 2007, and guarantees that it will use the entry place will be used
 - (b) Additional places- these will be allocated based on MNA competitors' finishing positions at the 2005 and/or 2006 world championships.
 - (c) Commission places - Entry places not allocated under points 1.1(a) and 1.1(b) may be allocated by an ISAF Qualification Commission.
- 1.2 The Target Fleet Size for each class is set as follows:

- 1.3 The number of Additional places available to the MNAs for each class will be determined after 1 January 2007, based on the Target Fleet Size minus the number of Priority places that have been claimed, per 1.1(a).above.
- (a) Additional places allocated under the qualification process must be accepted and guaranteed within 1 month of the place being offered.
 - (b) If at any stage of the allocation process the Target Fleet Size has been reached, the process is stopped.
- 1.4 All competitors in the Championships shall be a National of the country of the MNA which is entering him/her or which he/she represents (ISAF Regulation 17.5 applies).
- 1.5 Sailors shall be qualified for the Country Entry Place in national or international qualification races determined by the MNA the dates and results of which shall be known to ISAF.

2. Qualification process for Additional Places

- 2.1 Additional places are awarded on a step by step top to bottom basis. The number of additional places awarded to an MNA may be different in each class.
- 2.2 Additional places are awarded on a Round by Round basis looking at the results of the 2005 and 2006 world championship for each class side by side and then working from top to bottom of both sets of results simultaneously as illustrated in point 4 below.
- 2.3 When a competitor has achieved a qualifying result in both championships only the best result will count for additional places.

3. ISAF Qualification Commission

The ISAF Qualification Commission may allocate further places up to the maximum per event taking into account the system used in point 2 and results in other international events in the same class.

These places may be personal places.

4. Example about additional places

Here is an example based on the 2005 and 2006 49er World Championship results:
